

MEANINGFUL LESSONS in Participatory Evaluation experiences



To participate in this call, please follow the following steps:

1. Describe the experience and context. Briefly describe the context that you were evaluating, where, when, who was participating etc. (300 WORDS MAXIMUM)

2. Highlight the lesson. In what situation was this lesson learnt? Was the lesson learnt as part of a mistake or a success story? Was the lesson related to a specific tool, facilitation moment or other determining factor (context, resource etc.)? (300 WORDS MAXIMUM)

3. Draw out the moral or potential application of this new lesson. In other words, if you had to make recommendations to someone based on this lesson, what would you tell them? (200 WORDS MAXIMUM)

4. Provide an image. We would like you to include a photograph that shows an example of your fieldwork, a group gathering or activities linked to participatory evaluation (not necessarily directly related to this experience described). Also, if possible, a photograph that documents the case/situation (for example, if the lesson came about through a tool, you could share an image that helps us share this tool with others).
